Plastic production is increasing all the time and many governments are struggling to cope, shipping their waste to other countries who can't deal with the amount they receive.

Plastic bag sales in England's 'big seven' supermarkets are down since the 5p charge

was introduced in 2015.²

Over **90%** of plastic is made from fossil fuels.5

Research shows that 59 billion pieces of plastic packaging are distributed by UK supermarkets every year, that's 112,000

pieces each minute!8

The UK has been rubbish at creating a Deposit Return Scheme (DRS) for plastic bottles. It was first talked about in 2018 – and since then there have been all sorts of delays. It's not good enough, especially when schemes have worked across Europe. Norway collects 97% of its single-use

plastic bottles.3

Anyone and everyone can get involved to be the resistance our oceans need. It doesn't matter who you are, how old you are or whether you live by the coast or not. There are contributions you can make that'll make a difference. Everyone has a role to play! Here are some of the ways you can challenge your government:



Request a Q&A with your local MP/councillor to help you understand how they intend to tackle single-use plastic and hold them accountable to their actions.

Host a school conference; invite panelists and your school community. It helps to include a variety of panelists: members of the mayor's office, city council representatives, and your local MP. Perhaps start the event by screening Surfer Against Sewage's 'The Creature' film before introducing the panel, finish by inviting questions from the floor.

Schools were encouraged by the Government to go plastic free by 2022. Why not take and annotate photos depicting your journey to create a storyboard and send them to your local MP? That should grab their attention!



INVITE YOUR LOCAL MP OR COUNCILLOR TO A SCHOOL DEBATE ON SINGLE-USE PLASTIC.

Record a short impactful film with your key messaging about the problem with single-use plastic and send to your local MP.

Put extra pressure on elected representatives by getting in touch with local newspapers. They might contact you to cover your story, or ask you to be a source for a story they're already running.
